The items are paperboard packaging decorated with ink and varnish on the outside and without print on the inside.

For this type of item there is only used materials which is suited for the intended use of the items.

Specification of the product

The items are manufactured using the following materials:

Paperboard: CKB Nude[™]

Intended Use

Based on documentation from our suppliers the items may safely be used for food packaging and may stand in direct contact with dry and fatty foodstuffs, given that the food is **placed on the none printed side of the packaging**.

The packaging in intended for use under the following conditions of temperature and time:

- Freezer/fridge
- Room temperature (up to 40°C for more than 24 hrs)
- Hot-fill¹ up to 90°C

The packaging is **not** intended for use under the following conditions and temperatures:

- De-freezing or re-heating of food in microwave oven above 90 °C
- Conventional oven above 90 °C

Additionally, they may also be used as secondary packaging.

¹ It is the responsibility of the packer of the finished articles to ensure that the article is safe to use in the intended conditions. "Hot-fill" means the filling of any article with a food with a temperature not exceeding 90 °C at the moment of filling, after which the food cools down to 50 °C or below within 60 minutes, or to 30 °C or below within 150 minutes.



Compliance with European food contact legislations

Substances

Intentionally added shall mean deliberately utilized in the formulation of a material or component where its continued presence is desired in the final product to provide a specific characteristics, appearance, or quality. Please note that we do not analyze the paperboard for the substances listed below. Information below is based on information given by our suppliers.

MOSH/MOAH

We hereby declare that Mineral Oils Saturated Hydrocarbons and Aromatic Hydrocarbons are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

We are aware that both MOSH and MOAH can be present in virgin fibers used to produce paperboard.

PFOS/PFOA

We hereby declare that Perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS) and Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

Bisphenol A (BPA)

We hereby declare that Bisphenol A are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

Phthalates

We hereby declare that phthalates are not intentionally added in the production of the paperboard nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

Heavy metals

We hereby declare that heavy metals are not intentionally added in the production of the paperboard nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.



Compliance with additional legislation and regulations

Based on the documentation from our suppliers we hereby declare that the items comply with the following legislations:
